- **Training sessions and headcount completed in FY 2017 by Regional Government Group**
 - ✓ **Western – 8 classes by DOE and 1 by state instructors with 103 students attending**
 - ✓ **Midwest – 3 class by DOE and 1 by state instructors with 55 students attending**
 - ✓ **Northeast – 8 classes by DOE and 1 by state instructors with 135 students attending**
 - ✓ **Southern – 32 classes by DOE and 14 by state instructors with 653 students attending**

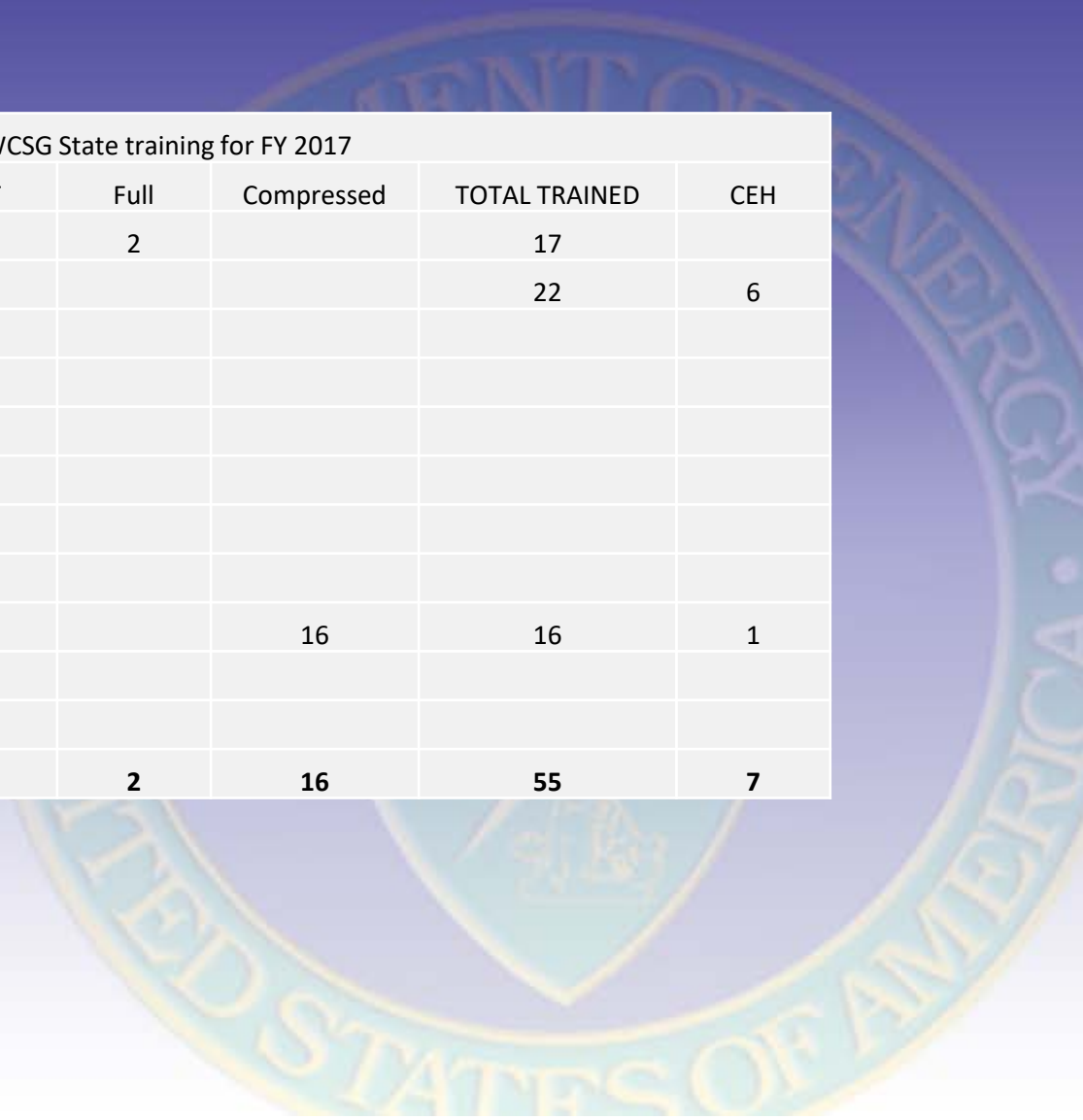


Routes

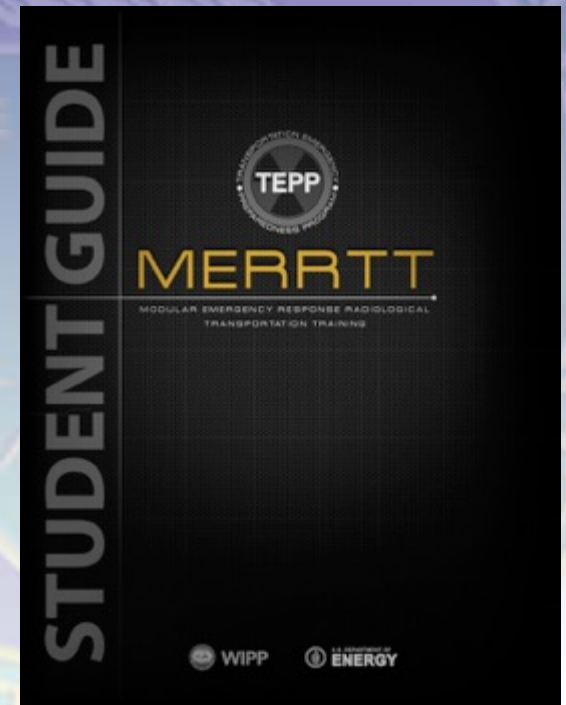


FY2017 Training Program Revisions

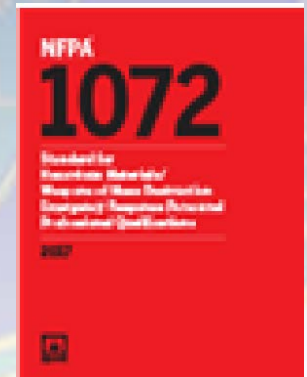
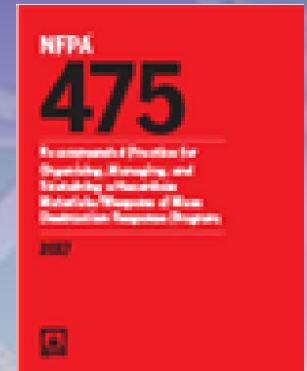
- **Agency Cooperation**
