- 4 escorts
 - o ANL
 - o CO-60 (2 HRCQ)

- May – accident carrying type A packages with F-18
 - No leak. All packages are good

- 120 LLW
- 9 HRCQ
 - In incidents
- Level 6 – 2 inspectors
 - ORS did not come to Indiana
- Becomes an Agreement State on Oct 1 after 5 years of working on it

 - Company is starting

Kansas

- No HRCQ shipment
- LLW-3 shipments
- CURRIE exercise
- Advanced reactor is being worked on

Illinois

- 13 Non- HRCQ
- 7 HRCQ
- 10 SNF
- 0 WIPP
 - 4 Million curries
 - No violations found
- 161 LLW
- 4 staff members attended a training in Louisville
- ROSS class in August 24-27
- Robust training program – monthly trainings (we should reach out and see what they do)

Ohio

- Used SNF (problems that were brought up in Fall)
- ROSS Class
- 2 HRCQ
- All staff is recertified for Level 6
- Numerous rail inspections
 - Hit or miss from FRA
 - Vermont Yankee
- TEPP

- Course coming up in August (once a year)
- Silent Thunder
 - FD was equipped with PRDs
- HAB for beaver valley
 - Ingestion for Perry in Oct/August
 - Reach out to Patsy and Chris if want to attend

North Dakota

- The GREAT state
 - Few HRCQ – DOT inspects
 - A few LLW from universities and industrial
 - N. Dakota high level waste consoul
 - Mostly educational
 - Future of Nuclear Energy
 - Regular meetings are being held
 - Road block that doesn't allow storage of waste but State is looking to remove that
 - Continue to follow progress like Wyoming
 - Coal plants
 - TENORM shipments
 - One landfill permitted to accept waste
 - They are excepting waste

Michigan

 - But can dispose of some
 - Palisades
 - 2 SMRs will be brought on to the sight
 - They expect summer 2026/Fall 2026 they will be fully online
